Dear Frazier Educational Community,

The Frazier Back to School Task Force has been working on a plan to safely return to school on August 24, 2020. With that being said, we are looking at all options to have our students and staff return to school in a safe and supporting learning environment. We have developed a safety plan, as required by the PA Department of Education, that will be approved by the Frazier School District Board of Directors prior to its release. This plan will address areas such as safety precautions, sanitation of district buildings, spacing of classrooms, and personal hygiene measures that will help prevent the spread of COVID-19. This plan will be fluid in nature and updated as the guidance within the medical community continues to change on a regular basis. Please know that the district will follow all recommendations from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the Pennsylvania Department of Health when possible, while keeping the health and safety of our students and staff our number one priority.

As stated above, we are working on a return to school plan to be release shortly that will identify the options that our parents and students will have for the 2020-2021 school year in accordance with our state mandated health department guidelines and recommendations.

Next week we will be calling you to ask you some very important questions that will aide us in our back to school planning. Some things to think about prior to those calls will be:

- 1) Will your child attend school since face masks are mandated by the PA Department of Health during transitioning to and from the classrooms and in areas where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- 2) Will your child use district transportation or will you bring your child to school since face masks are mandated by the PA Department of Health?

Please keep in mind, we are doing everything in our power to have our students return to school for the 2020-2021 school year in a traditional face to face setting. While doing so, we will need your cooperation and assistance during this transition period and throughout the school year as state mandates or health recommendations may change.
