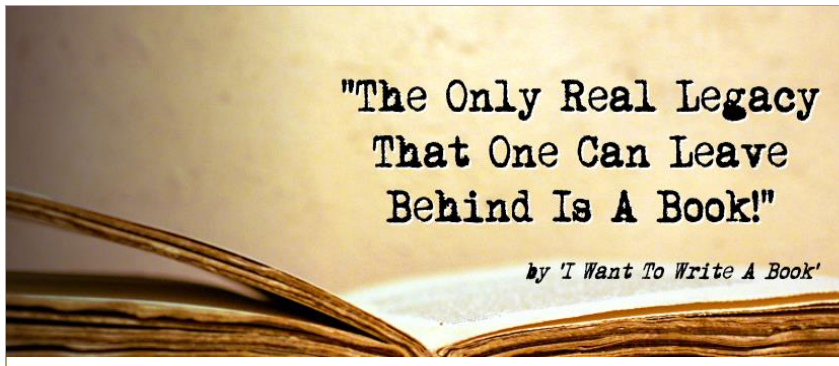
Realize why you are studying
