TIPS FOR VIRTUAL TEACHING

A guide for CCHS teachers to support students from a distance

COMMUNICATE EFFECTIVELY.



Use multiple modes of communication (Remind, Google Classroom, email) to reach out to both students and parents when students are absent. When sending messages to students and parents, be mindful of the time; avoid sending late night messages that might disturb students' rest.



KEEP IT SIMPLE.

Many of our students do not have the technology or internet access to download or upload large files. Make sure that the files, activities, and assignments you send can be completed with slower internet or limited storage.



HAVE A PLAN.

Absences are inevitable, so have a plan in place for how you will share lessons, assignments, and resources with students. Communicate this plan to your students and their parents so they are able to take the necessary steps to stay on track if they are not present at school.

Tutoring Opportunity!

An exciting tutoring opportunity for students is available starting September 8th! Students will enroll in a 5 week cohort that will meet on **Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays** from **September 8-October 7th!** Each session will involve math and/or English skills along with activities.
