Cooney</p> <p><b><i>Bleachers</i></b> by John Grisham</p> <p><b><i>The Adventures of Tom Sawyer</i></b> by Mark Twain</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Required Assignment:</u></p> <p>Compose a "Reader's Journal" chronicling your thoughts about the selected book.</p> <p>Students should write ten journal entries. Each completed entry will be worth 10pts.</p> <p>The journal entries do not have to be longer than five sentences. They should be made each time the student reads in order to record reactions to the text while their thoughts are fresh.</p> <p>Please write in paragraphs rather than bulleted lists. Scott Fitzgerald</p> <p><b><i>Fahrenheit 451</i></b> by Ray Bradbury</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Required Assignment:</u></p> <p>For each of these works, students will be assessed with an objective paper and pencil test on the first day of school.</p> <p>Additionally, students are required to complete a reader response journal. This journal should include a chapter-by-chapter personal response that includes minimal key plot points and looks to make connections in the text that are more analytical in nature.</p> <p>These should be handwritten; typed reader responses will not be accepted.</p> <p>Reader response journals will be submitted on the first day of school.</p>
