Several students did very well at the recent Archery tournaments. FBLA students competed last week at district contest with eleven students eligible for the state contest. Several of our art students received awards at the Kaysinger Art Contest.

Mrs. Eifert reported on elementary activities. Elementary enrollment is currently 255 with about 95% attendance. Tomorrow evening 70 students are attending an SFCC basketball game for reading rewards.
