ALTERNATIVE LICENSURE PROGRAM - EDUCATOR LICENSE WITH STIPULATIONS

An Educator License with Stipulations endorsed for an Alternative Educator (ELS-APE) may be issued to an individual who does not have a degree in education but wishes to become a full-time teacher and meets the following requirements:

- 1. Holds a Bachelor's Degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution with a GPA of at least a 3.0.
- 2. Passes the applicable content test for the area in which the individual wishes to teach.

This program takes two years to complete and is offered by a number of institutions. A comprehensive list of institutions that offer this path to licensure can be found at https://www.isbe.net/Pages/IHE.aspx. Once enrolled in an alternative licensure program, the individual will:

- Complete an intensive session (over summer) of methods/pedagogical coursework and, as part of the program, be issued an Educator Licensure with Stipulations endorsed for Alternative Educator (ELS-APE) once requirements of licensure program are met.
- Enter into the first of a two-year classroom residency as a paid, full time teacher of record with an assigned Mentor teacher.
- Prior to the second year of residency, complete any coursework required by program and be recommended by program for second year.
- Pass the edTPA (Education Teacher Performance Assessment) during the first semester of the second year of teaching residency.
- Successfully complete year two of residency and any remaining program requirements.

Upon program completion, the ELS(APE) will be exchanged for the Professional Educator License (PEL) via entitlement.
