PHS Hybrid and PHS Online Learning Models

 PHS HYBRID	 PHS ONLINE
Grades 9-12 Hybrid In-person & Virtual Learning	Grades 9-12 All Virtual/Online Learning
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 full days per week (8:00am-3:02pm) • Hybrid model that combines both in-person and virtual/online learning on alternating days • 2 days on campus, 3 days virtual/online, 1 assigned flex day on campus (as needed) • Students will have a consistent schedule of assigned days on campus (Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday with Fridays as the flex day) • Microsoft Class Teams-livestreamed lessons • Face coverings will be required on campus • Social distancing will be practiced by reducing the number of students on campus at one time • Extracurricular activities will still be available • Social emotional learning supports • Home internet connection needed • District devices provided as needed • Can transition to all virtual/online learning and at the end of each 9-week term (or if needed) • Free breakfast and lunch provided for all five days (Monday-Friday) • Bus cards available upon application approval 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 full days per week • Enrolled in Premier's online course platform-available 24 hrs/day • Home internet connection required • District devices provided as needed • Direct course support provided by Premier teachers • Social-emotional learning supports • Accommodations and support services as needed • Microsoft Class Teams • Extracurricular activities still available • Free breakfast and lunch provided for all five days (Monday-Friday)

PHS Hybrid Learning Model

- Monday-Friday (8:00am-3:02pm)
- 2 days on campus when safe to return to in-person classes, 3 days virtual/online, 1 assigned flex day on campus (as needed)
- Students will have a consistent schedule of assigned days on campus (Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday with Fridays as a flex day for additional support)
- Microsoft Class Teams-livestreamed lessons during regularly scheduled class times
- Extracurricular activities will still be available

PHS Online Learning Model

- **Enrolled in Premier's online course platform-available 24 hrs/day**
- **Home internet connection required**
- **District devices provided as needed**
- **Direct course support provided by Premier staff**
- **Accommodations and support services as needed**
- **Edgenuity online courses will be assigned to students**
- **Extracurricular activities still available**

Microsoft Class Teams- PHS Hybrid Model

- All hybrid model students will access Microsoft Class Teams for their online classrooms in the PHS Hybrid model and as the support classroom for the PHS Online model
- PHS Hybrid model teachers will provide daily live lessons, assignments, and communicate with their classes through their Class Teams
- Hybrid model students will have a Class Team assigned to them that matches each course in their schedule (3 full classes & 1 elective)
- Students have an assigned account to login and access their classes through the online Microsoft Office 365 portal.

Microsoft Class Teams-PHS Online Model


- **All online model students will access Microsoft Class Teams only as the support classroom for the PHS Online model**
- **PHS staff members will provide daily support as needed (8:00am-3:02pm)**
- **Online students will login to Edgenuity portal to complete their assigned courses with their assigned student accounts**
- **Students have assigned accounts to login and access their support classrooms through the online Microsoft Office 365 portal**

Hybrid Learning Model Requirements

- **Students are required to attend live class sessions daily at the scheduled class time**
- **Dress code needs to be followed for students to be on camera during class**
- **Students will follow Premier's online code of conduct**
- **If a student does not attend the daily live lesson, they will be marked absent from that class for that day**
- **Students must be on time to each class**
- **Live lessons will average 45 minutes for each class each day and the additional class time will be used for assignments and live teacher support for the scheduled students (each block class is 125 min/day)**

Online Learning Model Requirements

- **Students must login to the Edgenuity portal and complete assignments daily (Monday-Friday)**
- **Students will be marked absent if they have not logged into the Edgenuity portal and actively completed work by the end of the day (midnight-12:00am)**
- **The Edgenuity course portal is available 24 hrs/day**
- **Students will be expected to complete their assigned courses by the end of the 9-week term to receive credit**
- **Students are working independently with support provided by Premier staff as needed through their assigned Class Team support classrooms**



Student Norms in a Virtual Learning Environment

- Attend all scheduled meetings in Class Teams
- Follow school dress code when attending online class meetings
- Profanity, use of inappropriate comments or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated
- Cellphones and other electronic devices need to remain off and out of sight during virtual live lessons
- Use assigned break times to use the restroom or eat snacks
- Complete assignments and tasks by the assigned due dates/times
- Communicate with your teachers via Class Teams, Remind, video support conferences or e-mail as needed
- All student work submitted must be original and created by the students for the purpose of demonstrating learning or mastery
- Anyone who does not maintain academic integrity may lose credit on assignments that violate this policy

Breakfast and Lunch Offerings for All Students



All students are eligible to receive a free breakfast and lunch Monday-Friday



Scheduled drive-thru pickups will occur on two days per week



Students (or parents/guardians) are the only people authorized to pick up meals



The breakfast/ lunch drive-thru pick-up schedule will be posted on the school's website every week



A current 2020-2021 completed lunch form will be required for all students as part of their enrollment


Onsite Support Services

- **Families that require onsite support students must contact the school to receive approval and be assigned a scheduled day/time**
- **Onsite support services may begin August 17th as needed**
- **Students will not be provided in-person teaching until it is deemed safe to do so**
- **All students can receive distance support services as needed via telephone, e-mail, video conferencing, etc. Monday-Friday**
- **On campus safety protocols will be followed at all times to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 (social distancing, masks, hand washing/sanitizing, daily health check-ins)**
- **Masks that securely and completely cover the nose and mouth are required on campus**
