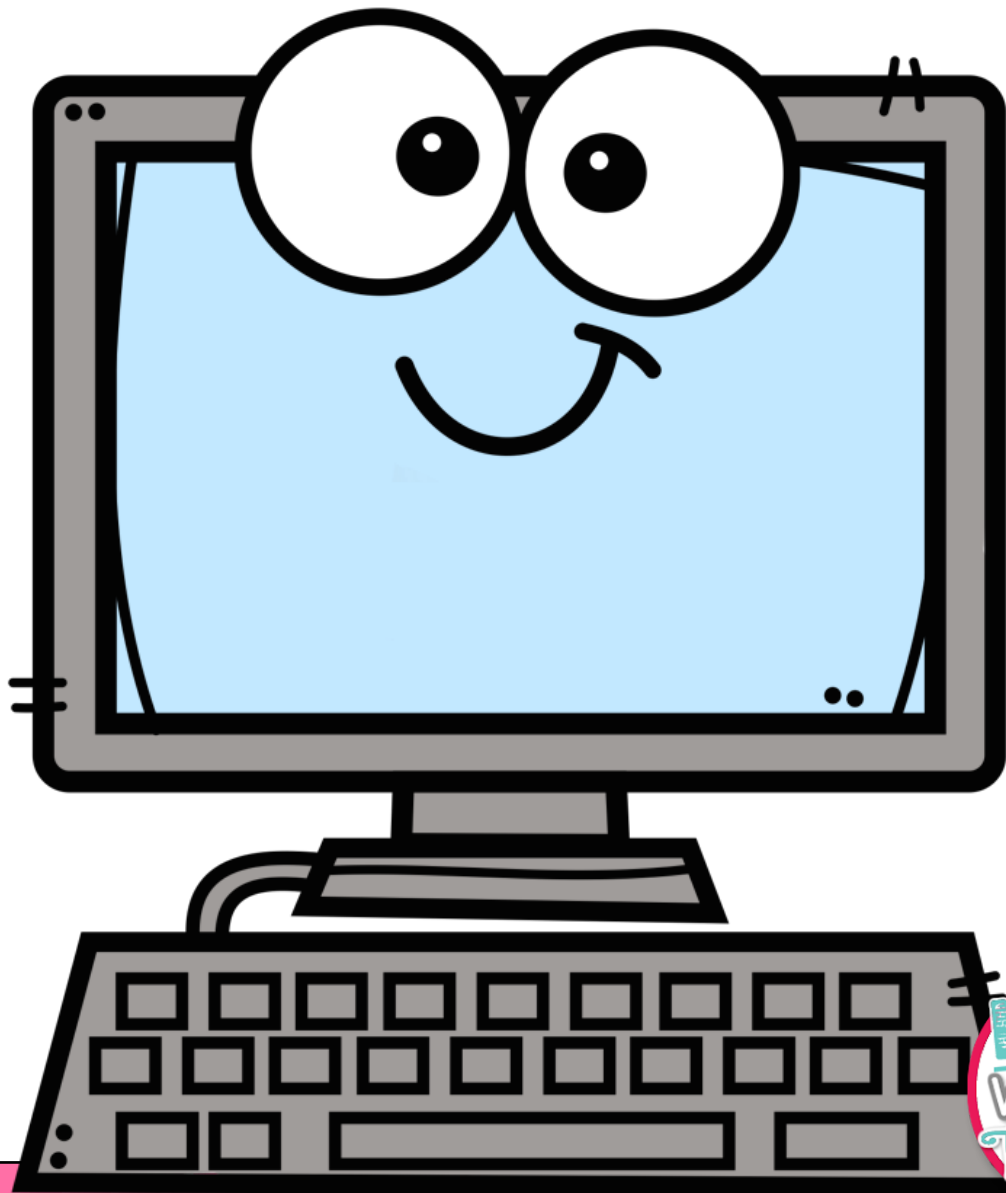


AT-HOME LEARNING OPINION WRITING

Two Ways to Share

You can send one link to students that includes all 10 days of videos. Or, you can send a different link each day with just one video lesson.

Using Google Classroom

Using Google Classroom you can create daily assignments for your students. You will be able to see their completed anchor charts and have access to their typed writing.

Without Google Classroom

If you do not have Google Classroom, you can still share these videos with students. You can send the links via email or your classroom communication tool (such as Class Dojo). Students will be able to use the link to watch the video and fill out the anchor chart. You will not be able to see their work as they complete it. They will need to turn in their assignment an alternative way—such as email. You can even have students hand write their essays and turn them in when school resumes.

Materials Needed

Students will need access to YouTube in order to use the video link. Otherwise, they just need a computer or a notebook and pencil for writing their essay.

Daily Lessons

At the end of 10 days, your students will have a completed opinion essay. The lessons take them through the entire writing process.

Day 1: Generating a Topic

Day 2: Writing a Strong Opinion Statement

Day 3: Using Reasons to Support Your Opinion

Day 4: Draft

Day 5: Revise the Introduction

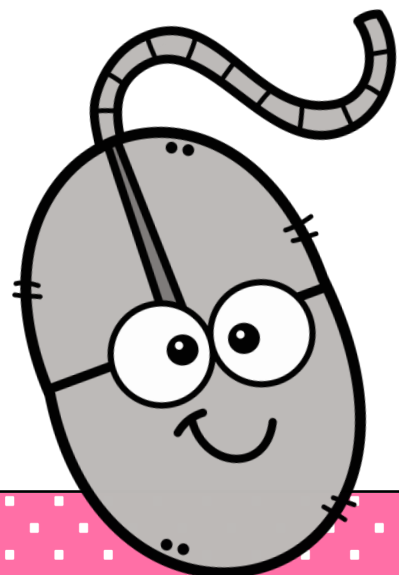
Day 6: Add in Examples
