# Transitional Model - Hybrid Return

- ▶ First Day of In-Person School
  - ▶ New Brighton Elementary School
    - ▶ Kindergarten & 5th Grade - Wednesday, October 21
    - ▶ Kindergarten, 1st, 4th, & 5th Grade - Thursday, October 22
    - ▶ Kindergarten 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th Grade - Friday, October 23
  - ▶ New Brighton Middle School
    - ▶ All Students - Monday, October 26
  - ▶ New Brighton High School
    - ▶ Group A - Monday, October 26
      - ▶ Group B begins live streaming from home
    - ▶ Group B - Thursday, October 29
      - ▶ Group A begins live streaming from home
- ▶ Timeline - This model will remain in place until further notice.

# Grades K through 8 Hybrid - Half Day

- ▶ Students attend school each day
- ▶ Daily teacher interaction for course/content learning
- ▶ Complete homework and independent work on Schoology at home following dismissal
- ▶ Hours of Operation
  - ▶ New Brighton Elementary School - 8:30 - 12:30
  - ▶ New Brighton Middle School - 8:00 - 12:00

# Grades 9 through 12

## Hybrid - A & B Day Schedule

- ▶ Students attend school 2 days in-person, per week
  - ▶ Group A - Attends school on Monday & Tuesday with Virtual learning on Wednesday through Friday
  - ▶ Group B - Attends school on Thursday & Friday with Virtual learning on Monday through Wednesday
- ▶ Hours of Operation
  - ▶ New Brighton High School - 7:30 - 1:30
    - ▶ Students complete independent work upon returning home
- ▶ Office Hours
  - ▶ Teachers available from 1:30 until end of the day to assist students who were home on a Virtual day or any other students in need of assistance.
  - ▶ While Live Streaming, interactions with teacher will be limited so students are encouraged to use office hours to ask questions and gain additional assistance.

# Grades 9 through 12

## Hybrid - A & B Day Schedule

- ▶ Virtual Learning
  - ▶ Students are expected to watch class live on their Virtual Days
    - ▶ Group A - Live stream and watch live class on Thursday & Friday
    - ▶ Group B - Live stream and watch live class on Monday & Tuesday
  - ▶ Wednesday - All students complete independent work
    - ▶ \*Wednesday is subject to change over time

# Students Remaining Full Virtual

- ▶ Students may elect to remain Full Virtual
  - ▶ NBES & NBMS students will utilize Schoology coursework and connect with their teacher(s) in the afternoon for learning sessions
  - ▶ NBHS students will utilize Schoology coursework and live stream daily into their class at the assigned time of their period.
- ▶ Families wishing to remain Full Virtual
  - ▶ Call Building Principal(s) prior to Wednesday, October 14

# NBASD & Family Preparation for Hybrid

- ▶ New Brighton Elementary School
  - ▶ Final Synchronous/Live lesson is Friday, October 16
    - ▶ Provide Asynchronous/Independent learning from then until return
- ▶ New Brighton Middle School & New Brighton High School
  - ▶ Final Synchronous lesson is Tuesday, October 20
    - ▶ Provide Asynchronous/Independent learning from then until return
    - ▶ Students **MUST** continue to log their attendance October 21 - 23
- ▶ Transportation
  - ▶ Updates on bus times, bus numbers, etc will be posted to our website

# Transition to In-Person Learning

- ▶ Daily Wellness Check
  - ▶ Families & Staff commit to Daily Wellness Criteria prior to attending
- ▶ Face Masks
  - ▶ Must be worn at all times; Except for mask breaks per teacher
- ▶ Water Fountains
  - ▶ Students will be permitted to have a bottle of water
  - ▶ Only Bottle Filling stations will be available in the schools
- ▶ Hand Hygiene & Hand Sanitizing will be promoted
- ▶ Cafeteria
  - ▶ NBES & NBMS students will leave each day with a bagged lunch and breakfast for the next morning
  - ▶ NBHS students will eat in-school on their in-person days and will receive bagged lunches and breakfasts for their virtual days.
  - ▶ Pick-Up will be available for students remaining Full Virtual. Details to follow.



# Transition to In-Person Learning

- ▶ **Transportation**
  - ▶ All students are 2 to a seat (3 if in same family)
  - ▶ Masks must be worn at all times
  - ▶ Load from back to front and Unload from front to back - Reduce students walking past one another
- ▶ **Technology**
  - ▶ All students should bring a fully charged device daily
  - ▶ There are NOT charging stations at school
- ▶ **Backpacks**
  - ▶ Students are encouraged to bring a backpack daily to help safely carry their device and school materials
- ▶ **Before & After School Programs**
  - ▶ No Cub Care at the ES
  - ▶ Strict adherence to drop-off and pick-up times, while acknowledging increased traffic on property
  - ▶ After School programs will be evaluated on case-by-case basis
- ▶ **Snow Days**
  - ▶ Utilize Full Virtual learning in place of Snow Days

<b>Covid-19 Cases During 14 Day Window</b>			
	<b>1 Student or 1 Staff</b>	<b>2-4 Students/Staff in Same Building</b>	<b>5+ Students/Staff in Same Building</b>
<b>Low</b> Community Spread	No Closure	Close for 3-5 Days	Close for 14 Days
<b>Moderate</b> Community Spread	No Closure	Close for 5-7 Days	Close for 14 Days
<b>Substantial</b> Community Spread	Virtual Model	Virtual Model	Virtual Model

\*Low/Moderate/Substantial as defined by PA DOH

\*14 Day Closure based on PA DOH recommendations in those situations, so total closure could increase/decrease based on guidance received
