Kansas School for the Deaf

POSITION TITLE: Registered Nurse or LPN

SALARY: Bi-weekly rate of pay depending on experience; Unclassified –Nonexempt position.
Excellent benefits.

SCHEDULE: Full- Time; 10 months per school year

EMPLOYMENT DATE: August 2021 (possible earlier start date due to training).

JOB DESCRIPTION: (Synopsis, full position description upon request)

- This position will serve as the overnight nurse at the KS School for the Deaf (KSD) Health Center. Requires Registered Nurse licensure, Bachelor of Science in Nursing preferred. This position works collaboratively with a small team of nursing professionals to staff and run a 24-hour campus-based health center serving students who are deaf/hard of hearing.
- Candidate must possess strong clinical skills and leadership qualities including: excellent communication skills; strong project management & organizational skills; highly motivated to learn American Sign Language (ASL); exceptional problem solving abilities; management and supervision style conducive to small team dynamics; supportive of personal and professional development within department; and a working knowledge of common conditions found in school-age children.
- Duties include, but are not limited to, maintain health center guidelines to provide ongoing care while the student is on campus or participating in school activities; attend scheduled training; provide nursing care to students, both in-/out-patient; be part of the team for individual health care plans; be available for administrative and clinical consult and support to health center staff as needed; ensure permits, licensure, and certification in compliance with State and Federal guidelines and procedures in accepted medical standards; assist in preparation of appropriate documentation and forms needed for enrollment; and participate in various team meetings as needed to represent the medical perspective. Candidate should be able to demonstrate professionalism and effective communication skills with staff, students, parents, and community members.
- KSD serves students from throughout Kansas meaning some students reside in a dormitory setting during the week while others are day students. The Health Center is staffed 24 hours a day, during the school week, by licensed nurses. Ill or injured students can be admitted for continuous nursing care if needed.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Registered nurse, licensed in the State of Kansas. Current CPR certification and current driver's license. At least 2 years nursing experience, pediatric/adolescent experience preferred but not required. Ability to communicate in ASL, or willingness to learn.
