

10th Grade Need to Know Checklist....

- Class Rings**
 - Jostens will be at school in August to order class rings.
 - Deposit of \$60 to order
- Please visit www.ACT.org to sign up to take the **ACT Test**.
 - School Code: 372-940
- Visit www.okcollegestart.org to create an account and start your profile. There are approximately 20,000 scholarships to apply for.
- Gordon Cooper Technology Center (GCTC)**: Sophomores will take a tour in the fall.
 - December 1st students can register on GCTC website.
 - GCTC interviews will be in January/February.
 - If selected there will be a second interview.
 - Selection is competitive so keep grades up and watch attendance.
- OK PROMISE!** Don't forget to sign up for the OK Promise.
 - 10th grade is the last year to sign up for the OK Promise
 - Paper applications are in Mrs. Lee's office or sign up online.
 - www.okpromise.org
 - The OK Promise pays tuition to Public OK Colleges and partial tuition for Private OK Colleges.
- The **Pre-ACT** is given in October to all Sophomores. (Only state test this year.)
- AWARDS:** Students can apply for the Kiwanis Sophomore of the Year Award in January.
 - Applications will be in Ms Baker's Office

- If you played a sport or were in band your Freshman year you may order a **Letterman Jacket**.
 - Orders are placed in September/October with a \$100 deposit.
 - Prices vary on jackets, but are approximately \$200.
- All Prague students that are Native American that have a CDIB card, check with Sac 'n Fox for items they may reimburse for; example: Class rings, Letterman Jackets, Announcements, Cap and Gowns, etc.
- **NCAA/NAIA:** See Principal Smith, Ms Baker or Coach Hedge if you are planning to play college sports.
