I am calling to make you aware of a technology survey entitled “Technology Home Access Survey” that was posted on our school system’s webpage as well as the webpage of each school today at 11:00 a.m. The purpose of the survey is to provide information to school system staff members regarding the level of technology access for students at home in the following two areas:

- 1) A student’s access to digital technology devices at home
- 2) A student’s access to internet at home

Please respond to this survey no later than 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 3/17/20. This information will be critical in our school system’s plans to provide instructional resources for our students during this time of school closure due to the Coronavirus crisis.

Also, during the period of school closure due to the Coronavirus crisis, our School Nutrition Department will provide meals for any child ages 0 to 18 starting tomorrow, 3/17/20. Breakfast meals and lunch means will be available for pick-up at the following school sites:

- 1) Trinity Elementary School
- 2) Ramseur Elementary School
- 3) Randleman Elementary School

Families may pick up breakfast meals from 8:15 a.m.-9:00 a.m. and lunch meals from 11:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. each day. A plan for the delivery of meals to additional sites is currently being assessed and will be posted to the school system’s website and social media outlets once the details are finalized.
