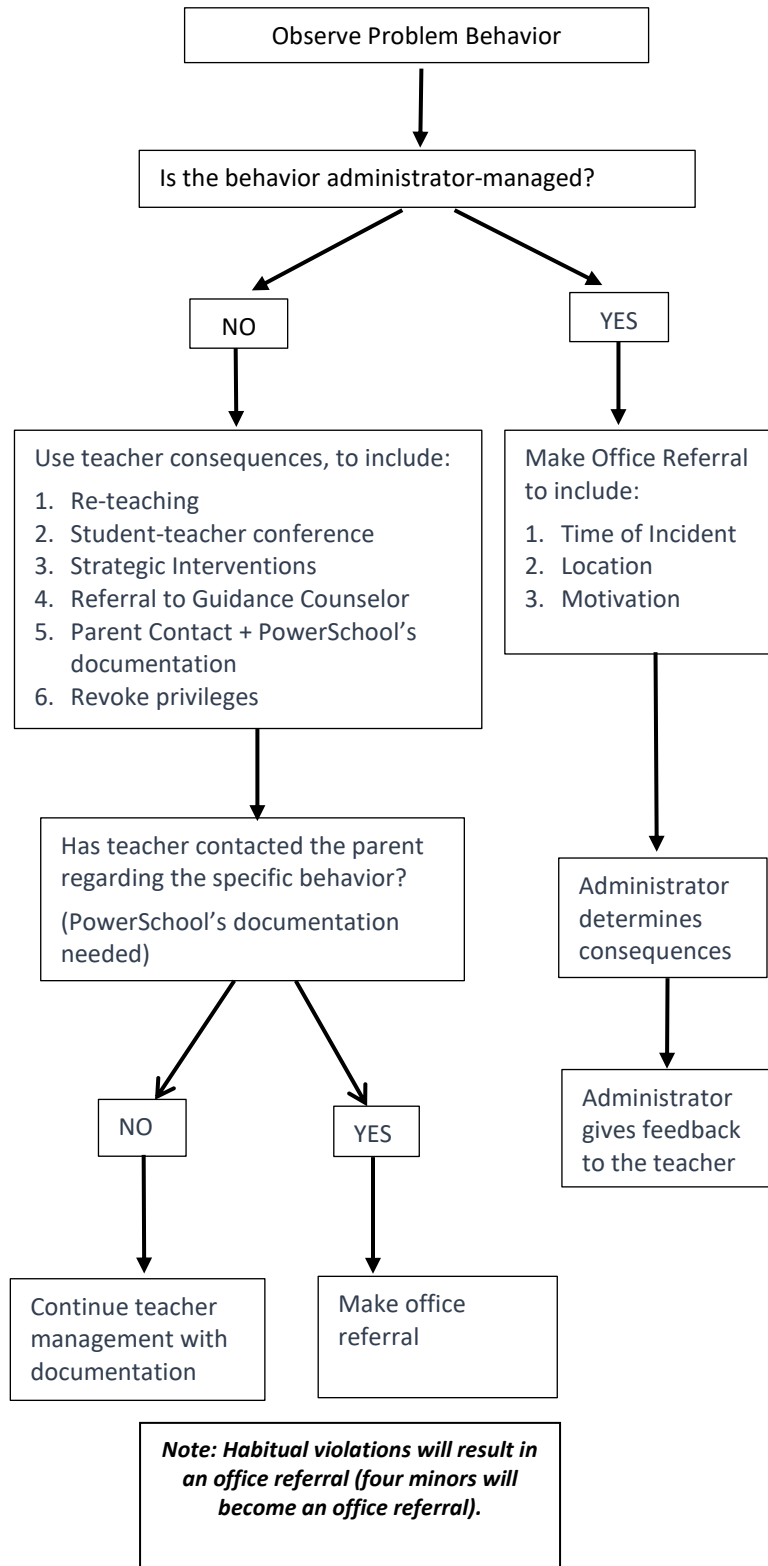

Behavior Matrix—Flowchart Procedures for Correcting Behavior Violations

Teacher Managed
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Academic Dishonesty* 2. Chewing Gum 3. Disruptive Conduct* 4. Defiance/Willful Refusal* 5. Insubordination (Disrespect to Teacher/Staff*) 6. Dress Code Violation* 7. Electronic Possession Violation 8. Non-Classroom Disruption (cafeteria/hallway)* 9. Possession of Unapproved Items* 10. Public Displays of Affection 11. Sleeping in Class 12. Tardy (to class) 13. Throwing Objects 14. Horseplay 15. Refusing to Complete task
<p><i>* Certain behaviors will be categorized based on degree of the incident or number of infractions to determine teacher managed or administrator managed.</i></p>



Administrator Managed
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Acts of Violence Against a School Employee or Official 2. Bullying 3. Breaking/Entering Burglary 4. Bus Misconduct 5. Computer/ Internet Misuse (including accessing obscene/pornographic materials) 6. Repeated Disruptive Conduct* 7. Fighting 8. Fire Alarm Activation 9. Gambling 10. Harassment (sexual, racial, or other) 11. Insubordination (disrespect to teachers/staff*) 12. Inappropriate Language (abusive or profanity) 13. Making False Reports Against School Employees 14. Out-of-Designated Area 15. Possession of Unapproved Items* (alcohol, drugs, fireworks, tobacco products, weapon), 16. Repeated Offenses (four teacher managed issues becomes an office referral) 17. Robbery 18. Serious Bodily Injury 19. Sexual Offense (contact or exposure) 20. Skipping Class/School 21. Theft/Larceny 22. Terroristic Threat/ Intimidation 23. Trespassing 24. Vandalism
