SYSTEM LEGAL STATUS

1.12

The Alexander City School System derives its legal status from the State Legislature which, in turn, is subject to the Constitutions of both the State of Alabama and the United States. Amendment III to the Alabama Constitution provides that the legislature may, by law, provide for or authorize the establishment and operation of schools.

The Alexander City School System is, therefore, under the exclusive control and management of the Alexander City Board of Education as prescribed above, and shall be operated in accordance with constitutional and statutory law.

The corporate name of this school system shall be the Alexander City Board of Education, and it conducts its business at 375 Lee Street, Alexander City, Alabama 35010.
