OMIT the underlined portion is normally correct if the sentence still makes sense when you remove it.

All of the other answers insert unnecessary commas

34. G

Starting a new paragraph would disrupt the flow. If you did start a new paragraph the new paragraph would only have 2 sentences which makes (H) and (J) incorrect. (G) is correct because it has the same verb tense as the previous sentence.
