Mr. Jamie Ard presented the elementary school report. They've finished a successful school year, with several activities such as Field Day, Honors Programs, other end of year activities that will hopefully set the tone for next year for parental participation. School Improvement planning and evaluation to target areas to improve, determine trends and figure out what we need to do for the next year to be as successful. Summer School started out well.

Mr. Cleve Roland presented the middle school report. Mr. Roland discussed several things regarding, ELA and Math Scores, Milestone results. They are planning a data dig to find out what kind of future professional development is needed. He expressed how encouraging it was to see all the kids in the lunchroom during summer school after separating them this year because of Covid concerns. Credit recovery is getting done and the bus situation for summer school has been worked out.

No report for high school. Mandy Long gave an update on FFA and Ag activities. She also gave out a handout with information regarding CTAE for Dr. Lovering. There were 74 pathway completers. Programs of study included, Agriculture, Business, Healthcare, Healthcare dual enrollment, Welding dual enrollment, Cosmetology and Criminal Justice. Other awards to note; There were twenty-four Microsoft Office Specialist Certificates given this year. Also, three Microsoft Office Specialist Certificates for Performance in Power Point.

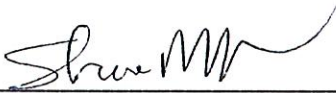
