



## BEECHER HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT DRIVING & PARKING FORM

Eligible students	Parking is a privilege granted to juniors and seniors who drive to school on a regular basis. Sophomores are permitted to drive after receiving a license.
Use of vehicle	Students may <u>not</u> use their vehicles at any time within the school day. Students who need to go to their vehicle during the school day must gain permission to do so from the principal, dean, or their designee in the office.
Parking space *	Spaces will not be designated. Parking will be on a first-come-first-served basis. Students may not claim a parking space as “theirs” because they have parked there before or on a regular basis. Parking in the gravel spots on Miller Street or Hodges Street is strictly prohibited. Kankakee Area Career Center students may park in Spaces 30-60 on the Beecher High School Drive.
Misconduct	Signs designate the entrance and exit to the student lot. Students who break any rules associated with driving or the use of the parking lot are subject to disciplinary action that may include loss of driving privileges without refund of parking fees. The police may be involved in issues of driving misconduct.
Vehicle Ordinances	All rules of the road apply to student driving and parking. Speed limit and safe driving ordinances will be strictly enforced by the Beecher Police.
Vehicle Search	Parking on school property and use of a school-issued parking permit gives consent to search by school officials and law enforcement.
Fee	A parking permit will be issued at \$20.00 for the year. This permit <u>must</u> be displayed on the rear view mirror of the vehicle used. The fee is reduced to \$10.00 at the start of the second semester but there is no reduction for students who request a permit later in the school year.

**\* Note that student vehicles may be ticketed and/or towed at owner’s expense for parking without a permit, in spots other than those designated for students, or in gravel spots on Miller Street or Hodges Street.**
