

Career Technical Education (CTE)

Pike County Schools' Career Technical Education (CTE) program partner with Enterprise State Community College (ESCC) and Lauren B. Wallace (LBW). This partnership offers many programs designed to better prepare students for life after high school.

How to be a part of CTE

Career and Technical Education are offered through traditional high school CTE classes and Dual Enrollment classes through ESCC.

The school counselor must approve all CTE classes for high school students. Discipline and attendance are also considered. Cooperative Education students must meet the minimum guidelines and complete an application process.

Dual Enrollment students through ESCC must complete an application and receive final approval from ESCC/LBW and their school counselor.



Student must have:

Minimum 2.0 GPA, hold a valid Alabama (state issued) ID, and be in good standing with discipline and attendance.
