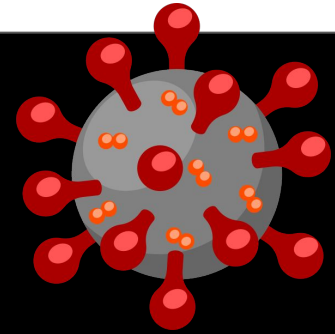
# Meet the Teachers

- Students will not be switching classrooms this year, due to COVID-19. The teachers will be switching classrooms.
- Mrs. Crystal Pickett and Mrs. Ashley Lawson will rotate classrooms.
- Mrs. Stephanie Shrum's classroom will be self-contained. She will teach math and reading.
- Mrs. Lynsey Smith and Mrs. Vickie Mosier will team teach.
- Mrs. Lynsey will teach math and Mrs. Vickie reading, and they will be in charge of virtual students.

# COVID-19



- Temperature checks taken/questions asked upon entry
- No water fountains - bring a water bottle to school
- Masks - required in the hallways and areas where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Breakfast - provided for EVERY student/eaten in the classroom
- Lunch - in the classroom 2 weeks/month and in the lunchroom 2 weeks/month (grade levels rotate)
- Supplies - No sharing. Supplies kept individually at the student's desk/cubby.
- Classrooms sanitized 3x per day



# Arrival



## Bus Riders -

- Doors open 6:45-7:00 (Bus Circle)
- Temperature taken as they exit the bus
- Socially distanced in the gym until 7:15am

## 2nd grade Car Riders -

- Enter through the **front doors**
- Door opens at 7:00am
- Temperature taken before getting out of car
- Socially distanced in gym until 7:15am



# *Dismissal*



## Bus Riders -

- Released at 2:20
- Load at the Bus Circle

## 2nd grade Car Riders -

- Dismiss at 2:30
- Load in the Front Circle (Around the Flag Pole)
- Siblings will load with the youngest sibling

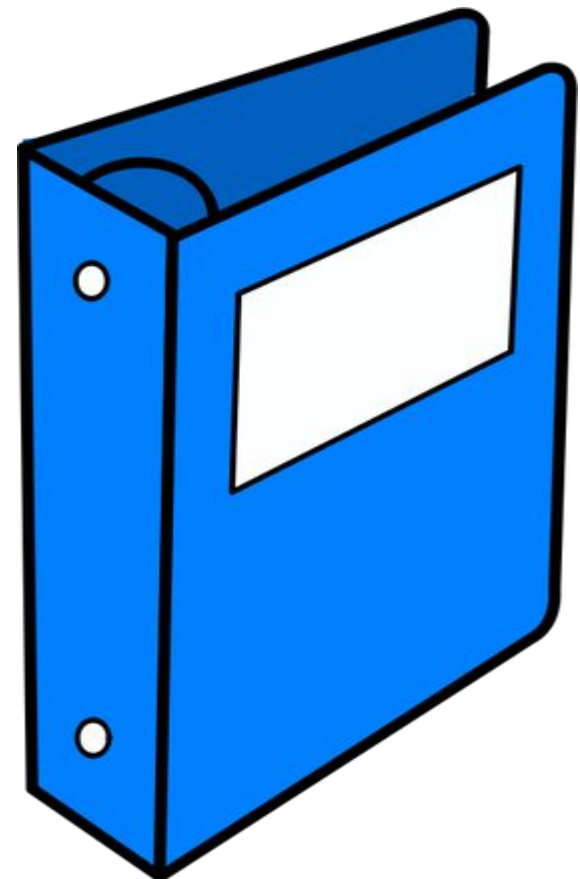


# Breakfast/Lunch

- Breakfast will be served in the classroom from 7:15-7:30
- It is important for students to arrive to school *on time* - virtual instruction is required to start at 7:30
- Parents will not be allowed to eat lunch with students this year.
- Lunch time 11:25-11:55
- We will have a lunchroom rotation schedule that allows each classroom to eat in the lunchroom periodically.
- If your child brings his/her lunch, please send items that they can open independently OR items that can be opened without someone handling the part of the item that has to be put in the child's mouth.

# *Binders (Blue Folder)*

- Your child is responsible for bringing back and forth to school EVERY day.
- Welcome Letter from teachers
- Weekly Newsletter
- Keep at home/Return to school
- Test Folder
- Behavior Calendar

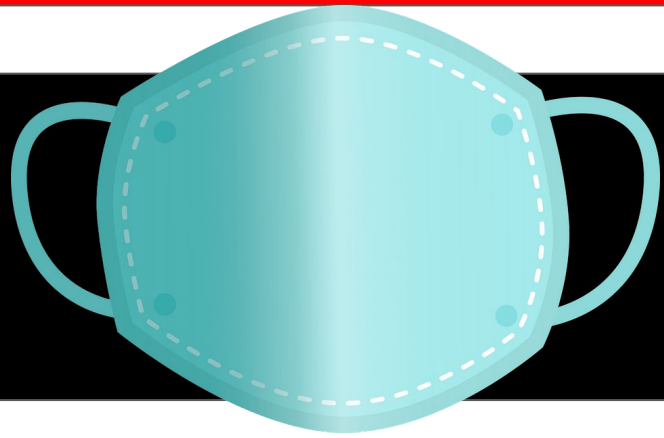




# *Water Bottles*

- The water fountains will not be accessible this year.
- Your child will need to bring a disposable water bottle from home each day, labeled with their name.
- Students will keep water bottles at their desks/in their cubbies (teacher preference).



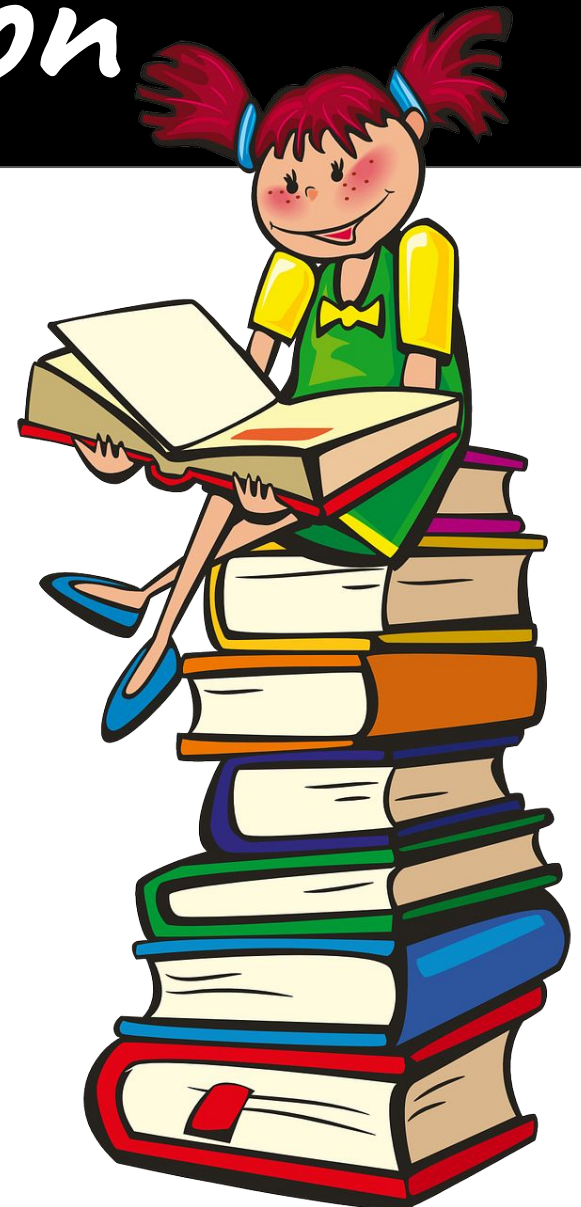


# Masks

- While masks are not required while students are in the classroom, they are a requirement for any time a student is in the hallways (or other common areas) for any reason.
- They may also be asked to wear while working in small groups inside the classroom.
- Suggestion: Have 5 masks, send child with new mask each day and wash at the end of the week OR use disposable masks and throw away at the end of the day.

# *Intervention*

- Students will not be switching classes for intervention as we have done in the past.
- During intervention time, students will work on review skills in their homeroom classrooms.
- Tier 2 and 3 students will continue to be progress monitored.



# *Related Arts/Recess*



- Students will not leave the classroom for related arts (Art, Music, Library).
- With the exception of Mrs. Grace for P.E., the Related Arts teachers will come to each classroom on their scheduled day to have a lesson with the students.
- Students will not be allowed to use playground equipment (ex. slides, swings, etc.), but we will utilize the outside space that we have to make sure that students have time to play outdoors.
- On days when the weather is not appropriate for outside play, we will do indoor activities from GoNoodle.

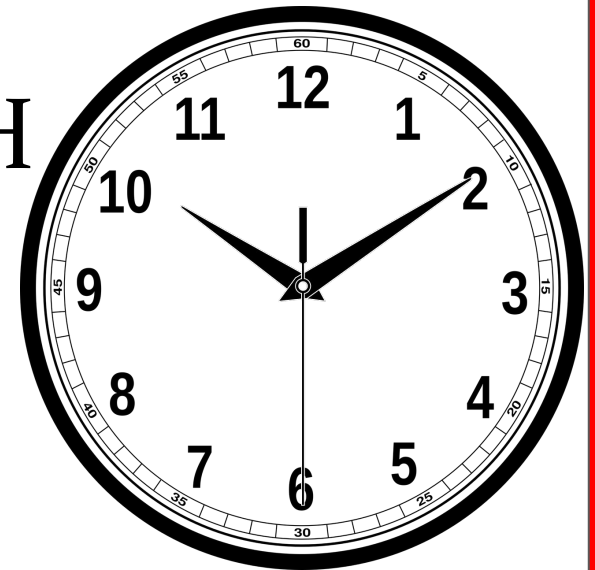

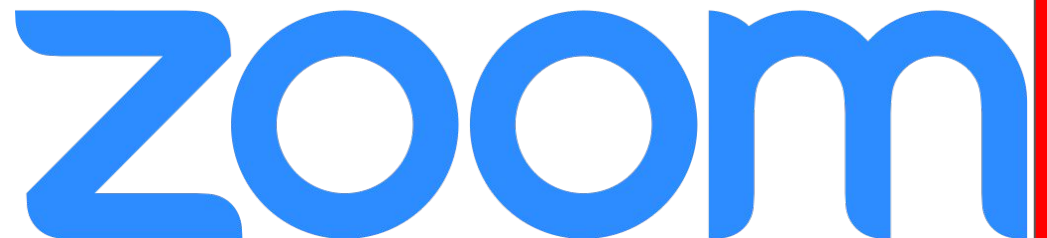
# School E-mail

All students will be given a school e-mail address that ends with *@westigers.com*.

- To access the e-mail, go to [www.gmail.com](http://www.gmail.com)
- Type in the email and password that you were/will be given for your child to log in.
- Virtual Students: look for an e-mail with the zoom links for classes.

# Attendance

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each online class.
- A student will be counted present for the class as long as they stay logged into Zoom for the entire class period.
- If a student does not remain logged in for the entire class time, he/she will be counted as tardy for that class.







# Google Classroom

- Students may be required to submit assignments through Google Classroom.
- This will also be used as a platform for announcements and resources for virtual learners.
- This is not something a student will likely be able to do independently at first.
- Your child will need an adult present to help with navigation of the computer until he/she is familiar with how to operate it independently (Ex. log into Zoom, complete and submit assignments using Google Slides and Google Classroom, use online manipulatives to complete activities)
- Spend some time in the next coming weeks familiarizing yourself with Google Classroom and Zoom. Make sure you know how to log in on the first day!



# Materials



- Students will be expected to be prepared for class each day, just as if they were at school.
- Please consider having your child a workspace set up with school materials easily accessible.
- Students are expected to have the following items in addition to their device:
  - Pencil
  - Paper
  - Math and ELA workbooks
  - Crayons
  - Highlighter
  - Small objects to count (beans, pennies, paperclips, etc.)
  - Consider headphones? (especially with multiple students)
