Driving and parking on the school campus is a privilege granted by the Limestone County Board of Education to those who are willing to abide by the regulations as prescribed by school policy. These rules are not meant to be a hindrance to anyone, but are for the safety and well-being of all concerned. Violations of these regulations or arrival to school late on a routine basis may warrant the suspension of this parking privilege without refund of the fee. Some basic regulations include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Students who drive/park on campus must have a valid driver's license. Anyone with a suspended license may not drive on campus.
2. Students must have current automobile insurance.
3. The speed limit is 5 mile per hour.
4. Students must park in the area designated for student parking.
5. Students must complete this registration form and turn it into the assistant principal or designee to obtain a parking permit.
6. Once students arrive on campus, they are to leave their vehicles and enter the building immediately.
7. No loitering in the parking lot.
8. Students may not return to vehicles during school hours without permission from the principal, assistant principal, or school resource officer.
9. Students are to leave school campus immediately after school is dismissed unless students need to remain on campus for a school-related activity, such as Scholar's Bowl, athletic practice/game, etc.

There is a \$25.00 parking permit charge. (Checks made payable to Clements High School.)

Clements High School will issue hang tags to students upon return of completed form and payment of \$25.00. Hang tags must be clearly visible from the front windshield. Hang tags are not transferable to any other student. Improper use of hang tags may result in revoked driving privileges.
