## Student Covid-19 Guidelines August 2021

Due to the recent increase in Covid-19 cases, specifically in schools that are already in session, the Franklin County School District will begin the 2021-2022 school year with the following protocols (These protocols are subject to change at any time depending on the circumstances):

- 1. Masks will be required in all school buildings and on school buses (Masks should not contain inappropriate, vulgar, or political messages)
- 2. Social distancing will be required
- 3. Students with any illness should stay at home and be evaluated by a doctor
- 4. Students that are directly exposed to Covid-19 will need to quarantine for a minimal of 7 days and may return to school only if symptom free
- 5. Students that test positive for Covid-19 will need to quarantine for a minimal of 10 days and may return to school only if symptom free
- 6. All indoor areas where students are present, including buses, will be sanitized daily
