Scheduled Board Work meeting to discuss Board policy

We started at I-0050

I-1050 – There was some discussion about curriculum adoption and eliminations and changes.

I-1250 – There was discussion about the music requirement. There was also discussion on providing instruction in a language other than English. Carm would like to see a good part of health curriculum be addressed to both boys and girls separately to give them the exposure of what is out in the world.

I-2450 – There was some discussion on gifted and talented students. Mr. Lackey and Mrs. Orthman explained that this is under the SPED umbrella and at this time we do not have any students identified in this area. Cindy went over teacher requirements and that we do not have anyone qualified to teach for this identification at this time.

I-2661 – There was some discussion on what the school is doing to involve more parent participation, with our elementary reading and math nights and that we are going to be expanding the program to high school next year.
I-2682 – Eileen asked if we were sending notices out and Mr. Lackey said that we do send notices out if there is a teacher not highly qualified in a certain area. It is also available through the state web-site.

I-2900 – Eileen asked if we had any students enter the school this year that were not English speaking and what we are doing for them. Cindy said that we currently have two and we do full immersion in the classroom.

I-6500 – There was discussion on field trips. The board will still approve overnight trips, we will not consider senior trips.

I-6550 – Eileen asked if the board members should be fingerprinted. The answer is legally yes. Volunteers must be fingerprinted as well. Carm had a comment about a substitute talking with students about other students off campus. It is a confidentiality.

I-6631 – have it titles School Volunteer/Substitute and have them all sign it.

I-7100 – Carm would like to have wording added in with regards to what classes could determine eligibility for valedictorian and salutatorian. The wording in here is sufficient and will cover all aspects.

J-0650 – add another bullet about immunization records (it's in J-5200)

J4450 – Take out the 2018 school year and just add previous school year. Fall eligibility requirements will follow current NMAA guidelines.

There were discussions on immunizations, requirements and plans for future in case of coronavirus.

J-5250 – Lice infestations cannot be excluded from school. The board agrees that a notice should be sent home to parents notifying them that there may be an infestation in our district.

For sections in between, if there was a law associated with it, the board did not feel they needed to go over it.
