HCCA Hosts New Audio Video Technology & Film Ribbon Cutting Ceremony Feb. 14



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County Career Academy (HCCA) will host a **ribbon cutting** for its new audio video technology and film (AVTF) program on **Feb. 14, 2020**. A brief program will be held at **10:00 a.m.** at the HCCA in room 127, followed by the ribbon cutting. A tour of the lab and refreshments will also be offered.

The program will include remarks by the AVTF instructor Candace Hollingshed, Principal Sabrina Phelps, and students who are enrolled in the program. Aaron Buzza, Camera-Ready Liaison of the Macon Film Commission, will also speak.

The AVTF program is an experiential learning lab for high school students interested in the television and film industry. This program opened this past August. Currently 30 students are enrolled.

“Georgia is the number one filming location in the world,” according to Lee Thomas, deputy commissioner of the Georgia Film, Music and Digital Entertainment Office on March 20, 2019.

This program prepares students for employment or entry into a postsecondary education program in the AVT career field. Topics include:

- professional ethics.
