The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Bobby Bearden, Chairperson; Terry Bramlett, Vice-Chairperson; Garnett Webb; Junior Farmer; and Emily Dunn. All members present.

Moved, seconded, and carried to move the second agenda item to the top.

Dr. Tim Rice, Director of Business Development of Highland Rivers Center, gave the board an overview of the services they offer in Fannin County. Dr. Rice presented the board with a proposal for Highlands Rivers Center to offer behavioral health services to Fannin County School System students in the school setting.

Superintendent Mark Henson reviewed the agenda for the regular meeting to be held on Thursday, December 11, 2008.
