## INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES AND MATERIALS

Instructional materials for Centennial BOCES' classrooms and Centennial BOCES' libraries shall be selected by the appropriate professional personnel in consultation with the administration, teachers and students. Final decision on purchase shall rest with the executive director or designee, subject to approval by the Board of Directors. All instructional resources and materials shall be aligned with Centennial BOCES's or applicable district's academic standards and support Centennial BOCES's or applicable district's educational objectives.

All textbooks, library materials and other instructional resources and materials shall be available for inspection by students' parents/guardians.
