In our classroom, we always work hard so that each child has an opportunity to learn in the best setting possible. This type of setting, in turn, enables every student to become the finest they can be! The students are learning how to be good team members in our classrooms, as well as in the entire school. To ensure each student is in the learning environment he or she deserves, we have developed the following criteria for maintaining a productive classroom climate.

Our Philosophy:

We believe that every student deserves a committed, fair, and professional teacher. Our philosophy of education is simple. Our goal is to meet each child where they are and to help, inspire, and encourage them to reach their potential. We will bring with us each day our love of children, positive motivation, responsibility, creativity, and knowledge.

School-Wide Behavioral Expectations:

DPES students will RISE! Respect Integrity Self-Control Effort (Students will also adhere to the Autauga County Board of Education Code of Conduct Handbook.)

The following Dojo point system will be in effect for the 2020-2021 school year. We encourage you to sign up for Class Dojo on the sheet provided to you in this folder, and make sure you keep the app updated on a regular basis to ensure that you are receiving regular communication with your child's teacher. Points are shared between classes and also used by PE teachers. The purpose of the Class Dojo system is to create a POSITIVE classroom environment and to encourage your child to exhibit positive behavior throughout the day. Every day, each student will begin with four green Dojo points. If a student chooses to break a rule:

1st green point removed - Warning

2nd green point removed - Silent lunch

3rd green point removed - Snack detention

4th green point removed- Parent note (Student written note that will need to be signed by parents) for documentation and office referral documentation will begin. (After student has received 3 documentations on office referral, the office referral will be turned into administration.)

Points start over each day. Please understand that negative behaviors impede the learning of others, especially your child, and we want to make this system as fair as possible for everyone. This system has been agreed upon by the teachers and administration, and it will be fully enforced beginning September 8, 2020. It is vitally important that we work together in your child's education. A disruptive classroom is an unproductive one. This discipline plan has been very effective for students and results in positive behavior, better attention, responsibility, and more successful students. Thank you for your support!
