Reading-

1. A great story for the 3rd graders is "**U.S Presidents: Thomas Jefferson**". Please be sure to complete the questions that go with it. This can be found on www.readworks.org
2. For a writing activity this week after reading about historical figures or some other important person that may have changed the world, choose someone that you consider to be "amazing" -either someone you've heard about or someone you know and create a book page that highlights this person.

Math-

1. Find, measure, and compare examples of area in your home or around your community. Example: Use square sticky notes to measure the area of various rectangular table tops or book surfaces.
2. Identify a unit fraction within a whole object. Example: Look at a whole graham cracker. What is the unit fraction if it is broken into 4 equal pieces?
3. Use flashcards, playing cards, dice, etc. to solve basic multiplication facts of 2, 5, 10, 0, and 1 by memory.

Science-

1. Look around the house and make a list of solid, liquids, and gases that you see.
2. Draw a picture of your favorite animal and research 5 facts about that animal.

Social Studies-

1. Create a book of Ohio facts.
2. Make a timeline that represents your life.
