Dr. April Greene gave an update of our $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade Math Mid-Year Benchmark Assessment. This test asks the questions in a very similar way of the Milestones. Dr. Greene also went over the shift in the way the questions are asked. There is almost a 3 part questioning system (the right answer, the work that the student did to get the answer, and the explanation of the problem with written words).

Dr. Greene went over the next steps for LJPS. Teachers are differentiating in all subject areas. Professional development will be focused on DI in Math to teach deeper questioning and higher level thinking. Teachers will participate in Math fluency training on 2/16/16 and 2/25/16.
