ATTENDANCE STILL MATTER!

Whether your school is providing education virtually or face-to-face, your child has a greater chance of passing class subjects and tests if he/she attends school regularly. SCS will monitor attendance daily to ensure that students are in class and completing assignments.

EVERY STUDENT EVERY DAY!!

CHRONIC ABSENCE- 18 OR MORE DAYS

-Missing just one day every two weeks can add up to 18 days in a year. Absences add up quickly.

WARNING- 10-17 DAYS
-When students miss a day of school it actually puts them two days behind their classmates.

GOOD ATTENDANCE- 9 OR FEWER ABSENCES -Students with good attendance generally achieve higher grades

Parent's Right to Know

In compliance with the requirements of the Every Students Succeeds Act, the Sumter County Board of Education would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s) and/or paraprofessional(s). The following information may be requested:

Has the student's teacher met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction; teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher. Parents also have the right to know whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications. If you wish to request information concerning your child's teacher's and/or paraprofessional's qualifications, please contact your child's principal.
