Penalties for players ejected from 1 or more contests are as follows:

- First ejection, minimum penalty of \$300 fine
- Second ejection, minimum penalty of \$500 fine and 1 game suspension
- Third ejection, minimum penalty of \$750 fine and suspension for remainder of the season

Note: After first ejection, the student-athlete can complete the online NFHS Captain's Course to reduce the fine to \$100 if completed within 10 days of the ejection. This can only be taken 1 time per sport per players. If a student-athlete receives a fine due to an unsportsmanlike ejection, his/her family may be financially responsible for paying the fine to the AHSAA by submitting payment to the school.
