

# Title I and Pottsville Schools



Title I... is a program designed to help improve the academic achievement of disadvantaged students.

### Title I—Funds and activities

- Our Title I funds enable us to have such things as:
- A Reading Recovery program at Elementary
   Highly Qualified Paraprofessionals and/ or Reading Specialists to support instruction
   Parental Engagement activities
- After School tutoring at Middle Grades

- Disabled Parents (right to ask for any auxiliary aid to help with parent-school communication)
- Written State Complaint
   Procedures (about
   curriculum-on ADE website)
