# CAREER TECHNICAL COURSES/CAREER PATHWAYS 2019-20

\*\*Please note- the Culinary program can be dual credit with Central Georgia Technical College, but students can enroll even if they are not admitted to the college and receive <u>high school credit only</u>. All other programs listed below do NOT require college admission and are not Dual Enrollment programs but high school credit only.

#### **AIR CONDITIONING**

• Students learn the basic concepts, theories, safety regulations and procedures of refrigeration. Topics include an introduction to OSHA, safety, first aid, laws of thermodynamics, pressure and temperature relationships, heat transfer, the refrigerant cycle, refrigerant identification, and types of AC systems.

## **AUDIO VIDEO TECHNOLOGY & FILM (NEW)**

- Prepares students for employment or entry into a postsecondary education program in the audio and video technology career field.
- Topics covered may include: basic equipment, script writing, production teams, production and programming, lighting, recording and editing, studio production, and professional ethics.

#### \*\*CULINARY ARTS

- Students learn "art" of cooking; growing program across state of Georgia
- Opportunities in culinary field are high in demand, wages and skills
- Gain knowledge in diet, nutrition, food preparation, cost & budgets and the science of food
