Information on schools/facilities which have been named for/dedicated to individuals:

Bonaire Elementary - new wing dedicated to Henry Cullen Talton (father of Sheriff Cullen Talton).

Lindsey Elementary - named for Reuben Wendell Lindsey (was principal at C. B. Watson Elementary when tornado of 1953 came through Warner Robins.) Mr. Lindsey had a heart attack and died that day. Lindsey Elementary was under construction at that time. The new school opened in February of 1954 and was named for Mr. Lindsey.

Miller Elementary - named for John Thomas Miller, a County Commissioner whose family owned the land

Pearl Stephens Elementary - named for Mrs. Pearl Stephens who donated the property for the first Pearl Stephens school. She was a church leader and a community leader. She also taught young people - though not formally trained.

Richard B. Russell Elementary - named for the U.S. Senator.

Charles E. Thomas Elementary - named for General Charles E. Thomas.

Bert Rumble Middle - named for Bert Rumble, principal at Warner Robins High School (Rumble was WRHS, then WR Jr. High before it became Rumble Middle)

Tabor Middle - named for Lewis W. Tabor, former Superintendent of Schools

Northside Middle - gym dedicated to Mr. Homer Hobbes

Warner Robins High - weight room dedicated to Dr. W. G. Talbert

C. B. Watson School - named for C. B. "Boss" Watson, a prominent citizen of Warner Robins and the first elected mayor of W.R.
