
## Supplies:

2 sheets of paper
Scissors
Glue
White paint (optional)
Watercolor paint (optional)
Chalk pastel (optional)
Crayons or markers would work too!

Here is the video for the lesson. This video was also made by Cassie Stephens who is an art teacher in Tennessee. She uses watercolor paint but if you don't have any you could use markers and bleed them with water on a paintbrush. She also uses chalk pastel to create the shadow but you can use whatever you have at home if you can be creative!
