Our Purpose

The Drama Club and Theater Arts program at Christian County High School hopes to provide students with opportunities in performance and technical aspects of the stage. We provide rehearsal and performance for at least two performance opportunities per school year through the Theater Arts classes and the Drama Club. Many of our students are involved in both. Our goal is to graduate an interested student with skills to carry them on into college in Theater Arts and with that in mind, we are working to build our program.



Students will be able to earn points for attendance, participation and active roles in all aspects of performance activities. Each student is strongly encouraged to have an active role in the club and work toward lettering.

Officers: We will have a pair of student directors this year to include a performance director and a technical director/or stage director. This will be a role determined by the club sponsors and by student active participation in class and drama activities.

We will also have an election in early September to determine club officers this year. The available positions include President, Secretary, and Historian. We will go through the application process in August and there will be a club vote for these positions. Students interested in these positions need to maintain good academic standing (2.0 or higher GPA) and club participation. Applications will be available when school starts.
