Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

Wyoming Area School District has an **INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT (IPM) Plan** for managing insects, rodents and weeds. **IPM** is a less toxic program that decreases pesticide use through prevention methods and by using non-toxic/less-toxic measures to control pests. The "**Pesticide Notification Act**" requires schools to notify parents and guardians who are on a **Notification Registry** when pesticide applications are planned in the school building(s) or on school grounds.

If you would like to be placed on this **Registry**, you must notify the District, in writing, and include the following information: Your Name, Address, Home, Work, Cell Phone Numbers, as well as your Child's Name, Grade and Building where he/she attends. Please mail returns to:

Letters should be returned to the District **NO** later than September 21, 2012.

If it is deemed necessary to use chemicals for an "**EMERGENCY**" pest problem, such as stinging insects, notice will be provided by telephone to any parent or guardian who has requested such notification in writing. All chemical applications will be applied after normal school hours. Notices will be **POSTED** at the main building entrance and in the vicinity of the area being treated at least 72 hours **PRIOR** to any application and will remain **POSTED** for at least 48 hours **FOLLOWING** an application.
