
## **DSISD School Board**

# **Dawson Springs Panthers Basketball Fan Guidance**

#### Spectators:

- Spectators will be limited to four tickets per basketball player and coach for the home team and two tickets per basketball player and coach for the visiting teams and two tickets for each cheerleader. Others will be turned away.
- All spectators must wear a mask upon arrival and during the games.
- Media will be allowed following KHSAA requirements and recommendations.

#### Upon Arrival:

- All spectators and workers temperatures will be taken. Family units and those who traveled to the contest in the same vehicle should sit together while the entire group should socially distance from other family groups. The first row of the bleachers will remain open.
- Only players, coaches, media, and game workers will be allowed on the bench side of the court.

#### Tickets:

All spectators will be able to purchase tickets at the door. All tickets are \$5 a piece (school age to adult) and you
must have the correct amount. Gates open 30 minutes before game time.

#### Student Athletes:

- All student athletes need to bring their own water bottle or drink labeled clearly with their name. No hydration stations will be available.
- Student athletes must wear masks during the event. Only student athletes that are actively playing in the game are allowed to not wear a face covering.
- Cheerleaders must wear masks throughout the event.

#### Coaches:

Coaches must wear masks during the event.

#### Concessions:

All workers must go have their temperature taken upon arrival. The workers must wear masks and gloves. Concessions can sell prepackaged items like candy, chips, and drinks. Popcorn, hotdogs, hamburgers, and sandwiches can be prepackaged by concession workers. All grilled or cooked items must be prepped and wrapped before the gate opens. Open condiments and condiment tables are not allowed.
