Because she has expressed interest in becoming a part of the showcase, we will like to take the time to ensure that she is aware of the criteria for becoming Miss Woodland High School. Our theme for the year is "Shine Bright Like A Diamond."

Please read and adhere to the following:

1. You will need to be a current junior (in good standing) maintain a 2.5 GPA and refrain from receiving any disciplinary referrals. Keep in mind that character speaks volume, and individuals are always watching you.
2. Because there is a possibility that you may receive the highest title at Woodland High, if you are chosen as Ms. Woodland, you are not permitted to run for the following: Miss Senior Class Queen and Miss Homecoming.
3. Your classmates are STILL allowed to nominate and vote for Prom Queen.
4. You will be required to participate and make special appearances in school events and community events (ie. Town Parades, School Opening Day, Board Meeting Request, etc.)
5. Contestants must be of good moral character and willing to represent her school with great pride.
6. Contestants will be judged on the point system provided to the judges.
7. Contestants should wear pageant-style dresses that are age-appropriate and compliment the wearers.. If there are any questions about the dress you will be wearing, please contact Mrs. Looper, Mrs. Primus, Mrs. Boyd, or Mrs. Lewis. At no time will students be allowed to wear two-piece, low-cut, low back, or high cut dresses that show too much skin. Judges will keep appropriateness in consideration when picking a winner.
8. The decisions of the judges are FINAL. Talking with the Judges while they are judging is prohibited.
9. Good sportsmanship is required at all times by contestants, parents and guests.
10. Contestants are asked to be backstage one hour prior to the pageant beginning time (5PM).

## FACT SHEET

### What will happen the night of the pageant?

All students will write, memorize, and introduce themselves. The following format will be used:

### Explanation of each competition

Note: Please plan to write a description of each of your outfits. This is due by **Monday, October 5**. Type and email (Ex: She is wearing...DO NOT write in first person...ONLY third person.)

**Dance/Opening Routine** - You will need a Pageant T-Shirt. The price of the T-shirt is \$10, also you will need to wear dark (non-ripped and holes) jeans and pearl earrings or diamond studs and necklace. If you do not have any pearls, please see Mrs. Lewis.

**Casual Wear Competition** – Casual wear should be age appropriate, dressy, neat, and stylish. Contestants should choose something fun, yet tasteful. This outfit should be something that you would wear out on a dressy night with friends. Show personality!

**Formal Wear Competition** – Contestants should choose a floor length gown that is age appropriate. Dresses can be strapless but must be tasteful and provide the necessary “coverage.”

**Talent** – Talent time cannot exceed 5 minutes. You must turn in a CD with your music on it the day of rehearsal.
