Mike Davis graduated from Northside in 1971. Upon leaving Northside, he served the Warner Robins community as a fire fighter from 1973 until retirement in 2008, and then again as a city council member from 2012 until his death in 2019. While Mike is remembered for these roles, perhaps his most well known role was as the radio Voice of the Eagles from 1994 until 2018, fulfilling play-by-play duties for the final 24 seasons on the air.

Mike married his wife Diane in August of 1984 and they have one son, Blake, who currently resides in Metro Atlanta with his wife Amy and daughter Stella. He also has 4 siblings who also graduated from Northside sister, Barbara (Class of 65) and brothers Lanny (Class of 67), Terry (Class of 70) and Gary (Class of 75).

Although Mike broadcasted games for all of the schools in the county, there was no secret that he was a loyal Northside Eagle. Only missing two Eagle football games in his 25 year broadcasting career. Some of his favorite memories are being able to broadcast all three State Championship wins for the Eagles. Mike was also very actively involved in the Northside Booster Club as part of the Executive Committee for a number of years. Northside was a special place to Mike Davis and remains a special place to his family.
