Alvord ISD Family:

Alvord ISD is announcing today that virtual instruction for at home learners will be restricted as of November 10<sup>th</sup>. A number of our virtual learners are not fulfilling the expectations for academic engagement and attendance. We believe it is in the best interest of all Alvord ISD students to return to in person, on campus instruction.

Beginning Tuesday, November 10, 2020 Alvord ISD will restrict virtual instruction and expect all students who selected virtual instruction to return to in-person instruction. Students and staff will still be expected to follow the COVID-19 safety guidelines established in the Safety Guidance Plan.

Students will be allowed to learn remotely only if they fall into one of the following categories:

- Students who have been quarantined due to close contact exposure
- Students who have received a positive test result for COVID-19.
- Students who are medically fragile and have a doctor prescribed homebound placement.
- A district or campus closure.

Below is a partial list of educational possibilities for parents of students who are currently learning remotely and choose to pursue alternative means of education:

- Withdraw your child to homeschool.
- Transfer to another district offering virtual instruction.
- Attend a virtual public school such as K-12 online or TTU K-12.

We look forward to welcoming all of our students back in the classroom and to an academically successful 2020-2021 school year.
