

Outdoor Contact Sports Opt-In Form

Updated 4/23/2021

This form is to be used by a school located in a county designated as High Risk or Extreme Risk to notify of its intent to opt in to offer outdoor contact sports for the 2020-21 school year in accordance with the Governor's February 10, 2021 update to <u>Outdoor Contact Sports Guidance</u>. Once final, this form will be posted to a school or district website and a link to it will then be sent to ODE.

In Lower Risk and Moderate Risk counties, practices and games for outdoor contact sports, including high school football, can resume following health and safety guidance to be issued by the Oregon Health Authority.

In High Risk and Extreme Risk counties, where COVID-19 remains more widespread, schools and other sports organizations can opt-in to resuming outdoor full contact sports with additional protocols in place. In such counties, sports organizations must offer on-site responsive testing for symptomatic individuals and close contacts, contact information for contact tracing, and a waiver identifying health and safety risks and a commitment to isolation and quarantine if exposed to COVID-19. Schools in Extreme and High Risk counties must also have at least limited in-person instruction occurring, with the goal of achieving hybrid or full in-person instruction for students this school year. Schools must also be in compliance with state guidance for COVID-19 testing.

Plan Details for School Instructional Model

Rainier School District #13 implemented Hybrid instruction starting Feb.18, 2021 with juniors and seniors and LIPI for other grades. Prior to that time we were fully CDL. We will have a weekly addition of grades with full implementation of Hybrid for all grades on March 1, 2021. We are also offering CDL to families that do not choose to bring their student s back to the classroom.

Students are on campus from 8am to 1pm on Monday and Tuesday for Cohort A and Thursday and Friday for Cohort B. Students are working with CDL on their off days. We are planning for a return of all students by the end of the 2020-2021 school year.

*On-Site Testing for Symptomatic Individuals and Close Contacts

OHA Requirements

Plan Details for On-Site Testing for Symptomatic Individuals and Close Contacts

Rainier School District #13 has ordered on-site testing kits and will offer on-site responsive testing for symptomatic individuals and those with known exposures to individuals with COVID-19. Students, volunteers, and support staff who show symptoms will be given a rapid test under the supervision of a trained staff member as per the OHA guidelines for the administration of COVID testing on school sites. As per these guidelines, any individual tested will be immediately isolated and/or sent home.

Each coach will log attendance for each day of practice using either the Google Form established by the athletic department or sign-in monitoring form provided by the OSAA.

During home competitions the presence of each official and support staff member will be documented.

When teams are transported to off-site competitions, records will be kept of athletes, coaches, and support staff on each bus. These records will include seating charts for each trip.

All contact records will be kept for 4 weeks.

Rainier School District will not allow spectators at home events until metrics allow.

COVID waivers are required for students in the Rainier School District #13. We will continue to require a signed waiver from a parent/guardian of each student-athlete.

Plan Details for Student-Athlete Waiver

COVID waivers are required for student athletes in the Rainier School District #13. We will continue to require a signed waiver from a parent/guardian of each student-athlete.

We have collected student waiver forms from each participant and have them on file. It was included as a separate requirement for athletes as they registered for a sport. We used the sample student waiver form and adapted it to our school.
