Dear Parishioners,

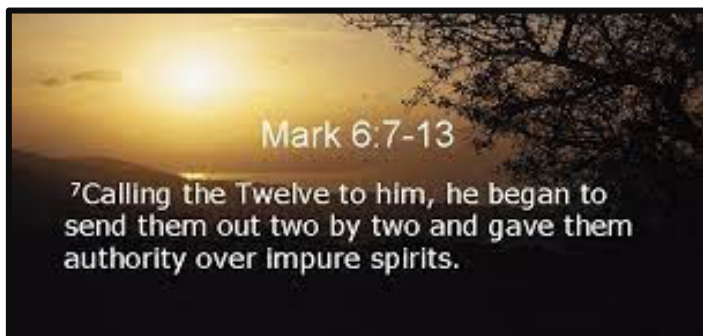
Please pray for the crew(s) who are re-shingling St. Edward's roof and working on the steeple this week. Because of the work, we will not have any Masses at St. Ed's so they can start early and work when it will, hopefully, be a little cooler. Work on the steps at both churches will begin soon, too. At St. Edward, we are just tuck pointing and replacing the missing bricks as the steps are secure as they are. At St. Eloi, the steps are going to be completely removed and replaced. We may need to use the side door for entrance and exit for the time that they need as that will be a multi-week process.

The roof and step project at St. Edward's is part of the Capital Campaign. We are still in the process of inviting people to give to the campaign to fund such projects and more likely air conditioning in the Church, some landscaping, and eventually painting the Church interior. Your generosity makes this possible and is appreciated.

St. Eloi's steps are being paid by a generous response to my invitation made just a few months ago. It is completely funded, and I am pleased, especially after the extensive campaign that the parish just completed. We received an additional amount that is in excess, and we are in process of getting bids for a new sound system. The sound in the area underneath the balcony is not as it should be, and there is not a simple fix for this area without replacing the system. The microphones and wireless transmitters/receivers will be most likely the only things that will be brought into the new system. If you would wish to make a contribution to this project, please mark it "Sound System." With all these projects at St. Eloi, I hope we are not fatigued. We know that eventually, too, we need to do some repairs to the exterior windows as they are dirty and dingy and perhaps coming to the end of their protective lifespan. Your generosity for this project is also appreciated.

As important as the upkeep of our buildings and grounds are, I hope that we remember the main purpose of our parishes – not to build and maintain 'shrines' but to build the Church as the community of believers. I invite us all to awaken a deeper desire to share the good news of Jesus, especially as we see a return to Sunday Mass. May we reach out to those who feel isolated or afraid and reach those who find it easier to remain distant from attending Mass.

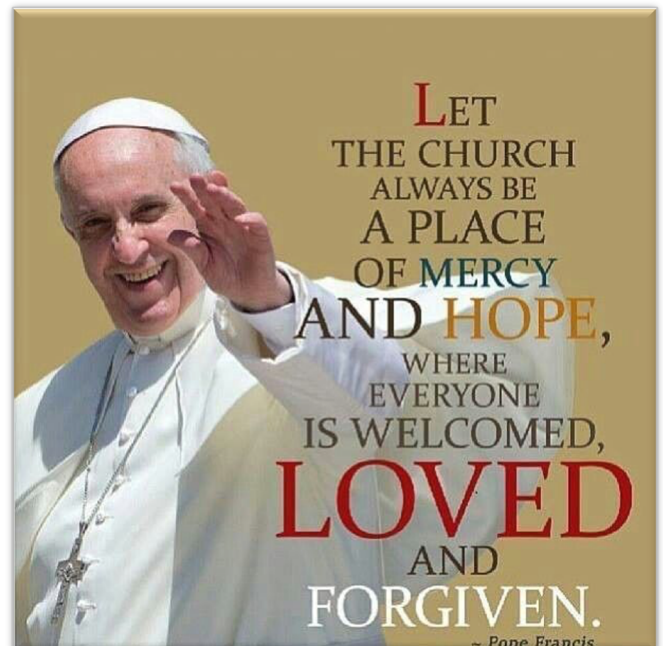
