Classroom Rules:

- Timeliness:
 - After 5 minutes late, the student will be counted tardy.
 - After 15 minutes late, the student will be counted absent.
- Visibility/Attendance: (Google Meets)
 - Videos must be turned on the entire class period and maintain visibility to receive attendance credit (see HSSD Enhanced Virtual Expectations Policy).
- Dress Code:
 - A school uniform shirt is required.
 - Refrain from inappropriate headdress.

Classroom Expectations:

- Participation:
 - Contribute to classroom discussions, reading, speaking/responding, unmuting/typing in chats.
- Assignments:
 - Submit work on-time.
 - All assignments will be graded.
 - Completion of all assignments is expected.
 - Make-up work in a timely manner.
 - A zero will be a placeholder until the assignment is completed.
- Golden Rule: "Treat others the way you want to be treated."
 - Respect the diversity of others' thoughts, beliefs, or identities.
- Academic/Formal Language:
 - Use proper written and spoken language when participating in virtual classrooms and when completing assignments.
