Edgenuity and Odysseyware Courses

Below is a chart of the different types of Edgenuity and Odysseyware courses.

Odysseyware Quarterly Courses

- ⇒ These courses are designed for K-5 grade students.
- ⇒ Full-time virtual students are enrolled in these courses.
- ⇒ The virtual teacher will monitor students enrolled in these courses.
- ⇒ The virtual teacher will assign grades in iNOW.

Odysseyware Mini-Module Courses

- ⇒ These courses are designed for K-5 grade students.
- ⇒ Students who are in the traditional setting are enrolled in these courses.
- ⇒ The classroom teacher who should assign a weekly lesson to the entire class on the first day of the new week.
- ⇒ Students who are absent from class will be assigned make up work (per the ECPS Blended Attendance Policy) in Odysseyware.

Edgenuity ECAP Courses

- ⇒ These courses are designed for 6-12 grade students.
- ⇒ These courses will begin with "*ECAP" and end with "2020".
- ⇒ Teachers should use these courses to assign work for student assigned to ECAP.
- ⇒ Base school teachers will assign work to their students, but ECAP teachers will monitor student's progress.

Edgenuity Virtual Learning Courses

- ⇒ These courses are designed for 6-12 grade students.
- ⇒ These courses will end with the words "Virtual Learning".
- ⇒ These courses are designed for students who are enrolled at the base school but are participating in the virtual platform.
- ⇒ These courses do not have "free movement" and students must follow the progression of the course.
- ⇒ The virtual teacher will assign courses and monitor students enrolled in these courses.

Edgenuity Blended Learning Courses

- ⇒ These courses are designed for blended attendance. Students who are absent from class will be assigned make up work (Blended Attendance Policy).
- $\Rightarrow\,$ These courses will begin with "ECPS" and end with "BL".
- \Rightarrow 6-12 grade students in the traditional setting are enrolled in these courses.
- ⇒ 6-12 grade teachers must include these lessons in their weekly lesson plans and assign/post them so that students are aware of which Edgenuity lesson to complete when absent each week.
- ⇒ 6-12 grade teachers should assign a lesson per week to the entire class to acclimate the students to the program.
- ⇒ BL courses are on free movement, so students can move to the specific lesson they are instructed to complete.
