Our society needs to hear a prophetic voice like Micah's. VI. It takes a bold and courageous Spirit to call "sin" "sin" and to stand up for the truth of God's Word. VII. Jesus spoke out against the Scribes and Pharisees' hypocrisy and sin, and it cost Him His life. VIII. Pentecost Power was given to Jesus' disciples, including us. IX. We have been chosen and empowered by the Holy Spirit in our Baptism, to carry out Jesus' mission: To be His bold and courageous witnesses. To call out sin. And to extend grace to all who would repent and believe the Gospel. X.
