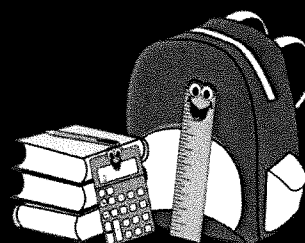


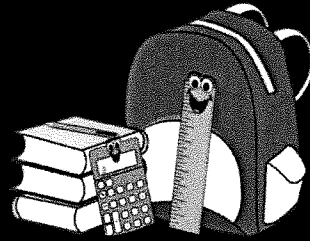
## Contact Information

## Dress Code

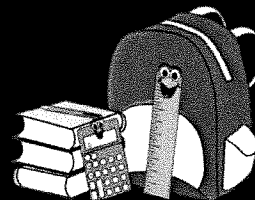
### BOYS


1. Shirts should be an appropriate length.

\*Jacket or sweater may be needed in the classroom.






**Tiger Pride**





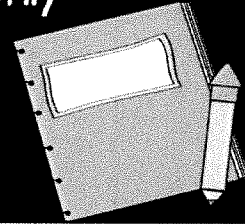
# Homework
