September

- I can sort objects by shape, size, color, and thickness.

October

- I can name the following two dimensional shapes – circle, square, oval, rectangle, triangle, diamond/rhombus.

November

- I can extend simple patterns using shape, color, and size.

December

- I can identify simple patterns as repeating, growing or shrinking.
- I can create simple patterns using shape, color, and size.

January

- I can order three objects by length and weight.

February

- I can count forward, with and without objects, to at least 100.

March

- I know that a number can represent a group of objects in various arrangements.

April

- I can count backward with and without objects, from 20 to 0.

May

- I can read, write, and represent numbers from 0 to at least 31.
