



GENERAL STATEMENT

Fellow graduates and friends of Les Horsager (Class of 1954) wish to honor their friend by establishing a memorial scholarship fund in his honor. Two scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded for the 2018, 2019, and 2020 school years. The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage seniors graduating from Verndale High School to pursue educational training at the post-secondary level. The graduating senior must be planning to continue his/her education at a college, university, community college or technical college. Preference will be given to the highest ranking male and female student. The award amount will be **\$1,000.00**.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. The award recipient must be a graduating senior at Verndale High School.
- 2. There will be no restrictions as to race, color, creed, religion, disability, sexual orientation, status with regard to public assistance, or national origin.
- 3. The award recipient must pursue educational training at the post-secondary level.
- 4. The award recipient will be the highest ranking male and female student in the class.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection committee shall be members of the Citizens Scholarship Committee; the committee shall review the applications on the basis of:

- 1. Post-Secondary Plans
- 2. Class Rank

**The scholarship will be paid to the educational institution at the beginning of the second term upon proof of successful completion of first term and registration for second term classes.
