ORGANIZATION AND OFFICERS OF THE BOARD

2.21

- I. A President and a Vice-President, and such other officers as the Board may determine, shall be elected annually in November by the Barbour County Board of Education.
- II. The President shall preside at all Barbour County Board of Education meetings, appoint committees, and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by law or by action of the Barbour County Board of Education. The Vice-President shall preside in the absence of the President and shall perform such other duties of the President as required by circumstances.
- III. The Superintendent, as provided by law, shall be the secretary and executive officer of the Barbour County Board of Education.
