Technology Goal, 2012-2017

- Our goal is to equip our teachers and students with the tools necessary to teach and learn in a manner that is consistent with our mission to produce high-achieving students and our vision that our system will be world class.
- Today's classroom technology should include interactive boards, projectors, computers, document cameras and student response systems



Technology Progress

Technology was significantly improved!

Classrooms now meet 21st Century standards.

Up-to-date computers were added.

- ✓ 2,595 lab computers
- ✓ 1,235 laptops for students
- ✓ 2,860 desktop stations for teachers
- ✓ 1,200 mobile wireless laptops (in mobile carts)
- ✓ 56 iMac graphic lab computers
- ✓ thin client labs in media centers



Other teaching tools were also added.

- ✓ 1,279 interactive boards
- ✓ 1,144 projectors
- ✓ 1,316 document cameras
- ✓ 29 media center touch panel self check-outs

- ✓ Notebook software for instruction (SMART)

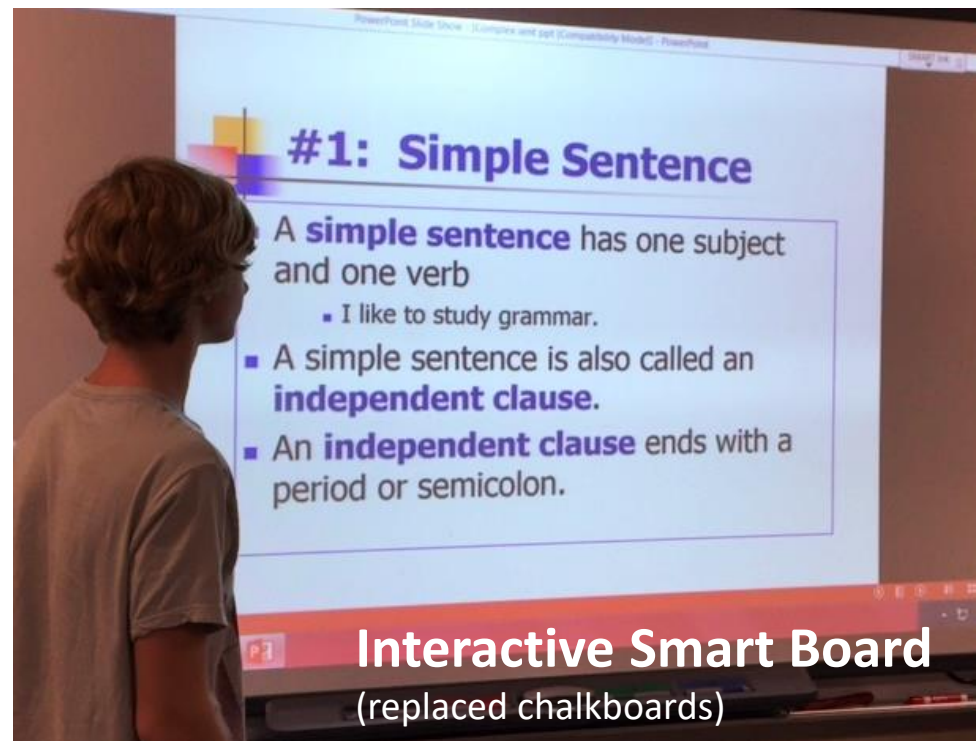


Infrastructure was tremendously improved.

- ✓ Added virtual server for school data



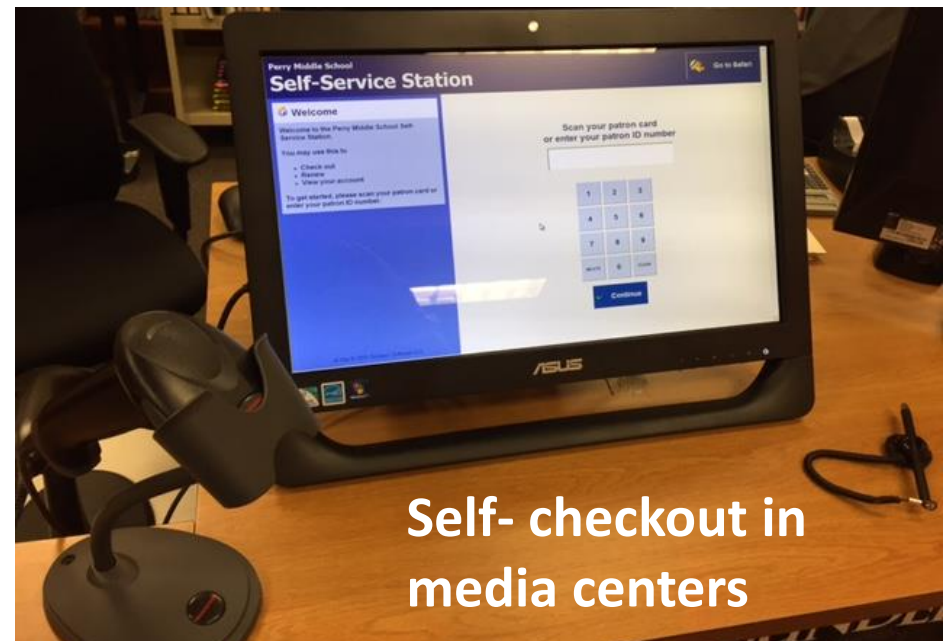

Safety & Security

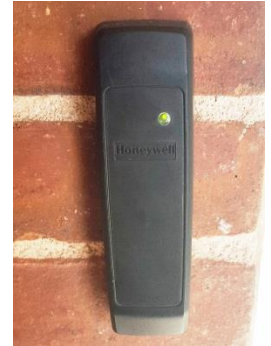
All sites received security upgrades.



- ✓ 381 IP security cameras were added for better coverage, increasing total number of cameras to 824.
- ✓ 11 Digital Sentry Servers for IP recording and storage were added.
- ✓ Ran infrastructure in preparation to change 443 analog cameras to IP in the future.

Safety & Security

- ✓ **Access control** was improved at 12 sites.
- ✓ **Locks** with scanners were installed to better control building access.
- ✓ The **fire alarm system** was also replaced at 2 schools.

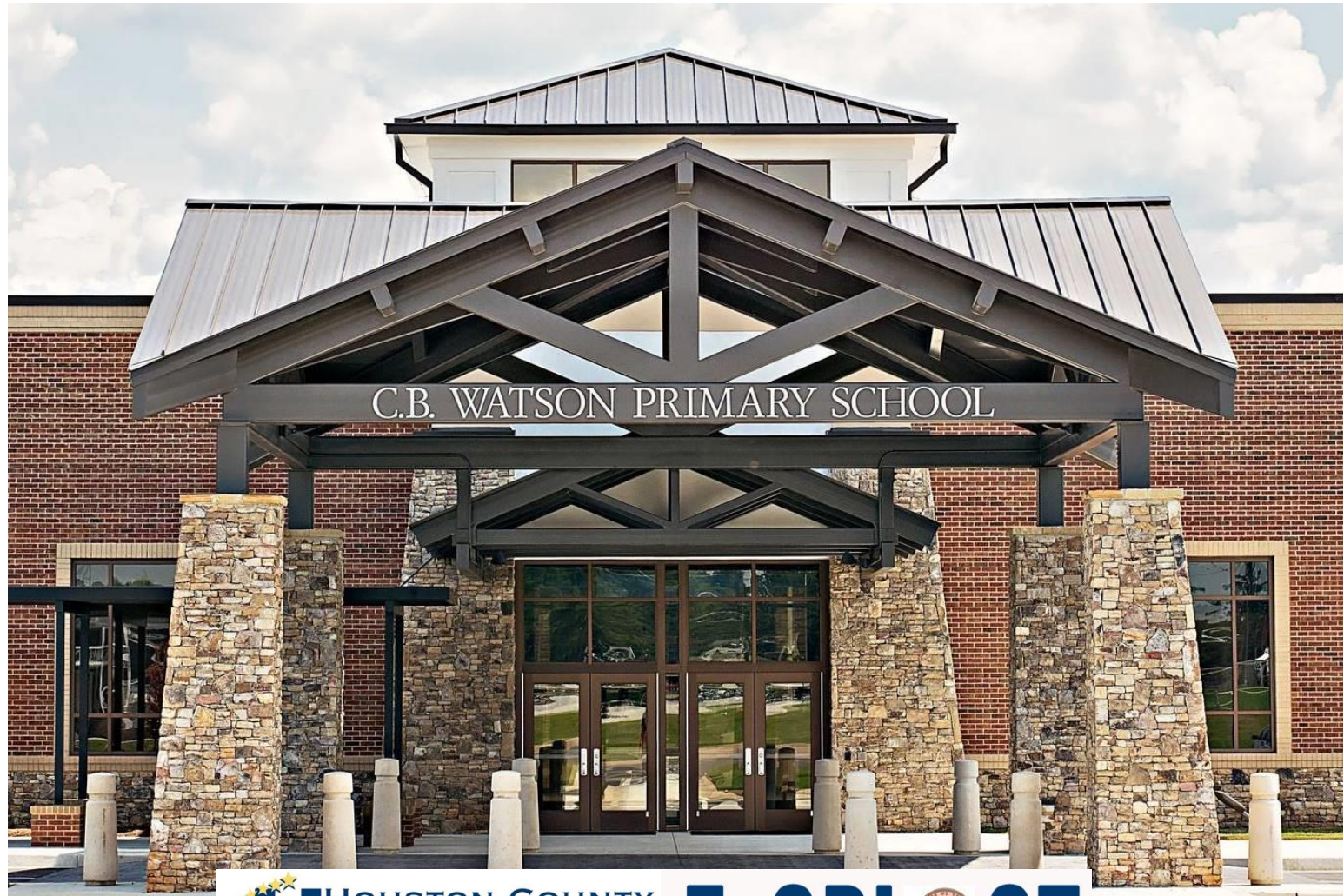

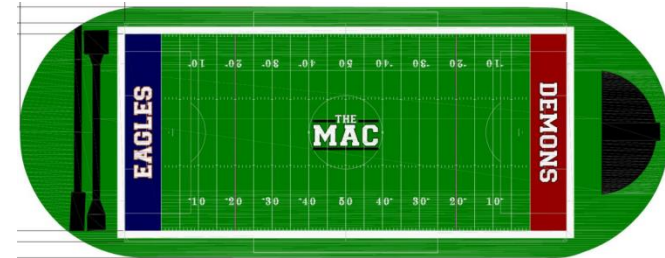

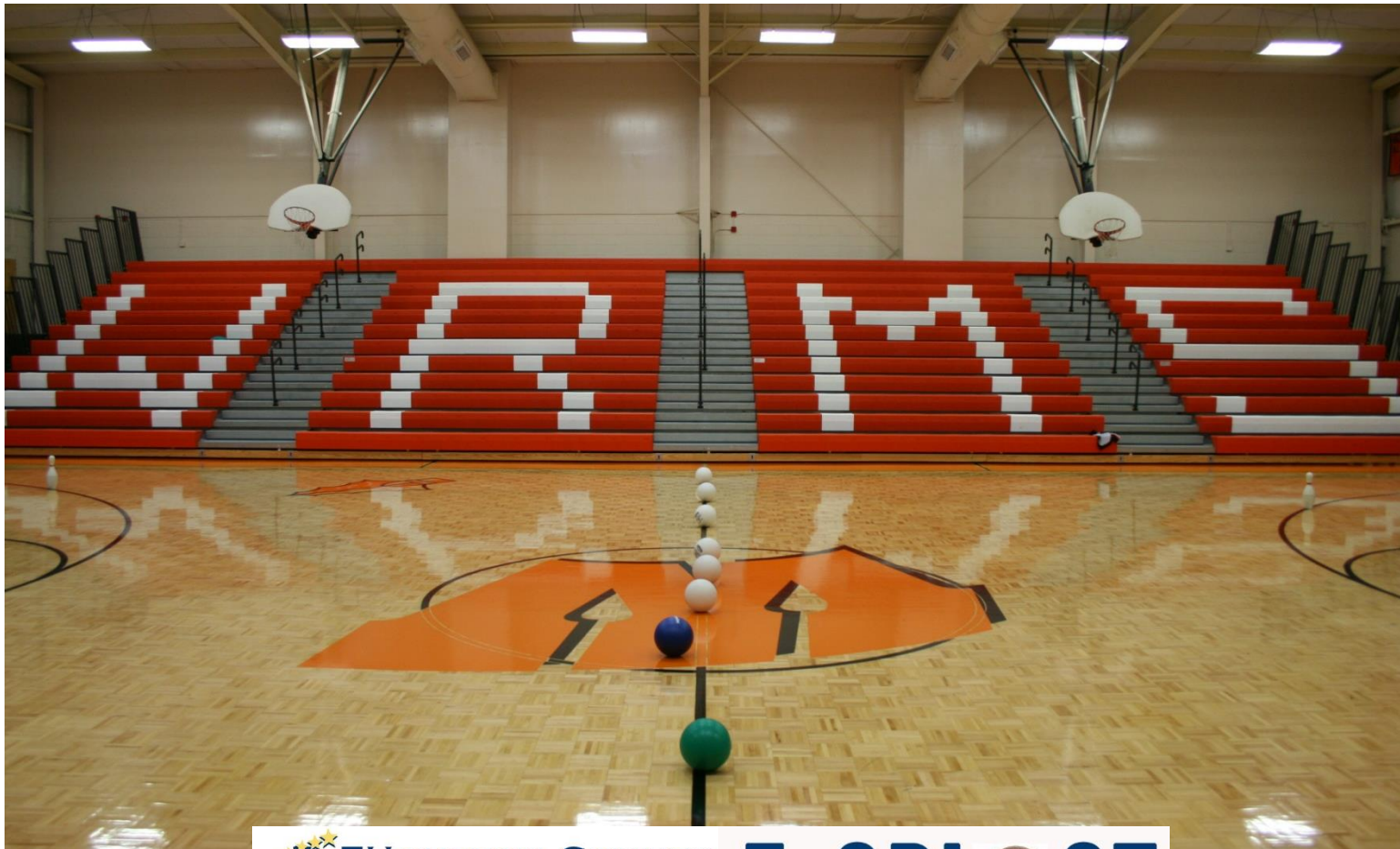

Carpet was worn and needed replacing; walls and door frames also needed fresh paint.

Hallways Improved at 14 Schools

- ✓ Removed and replaced ~320,000 square feet of tile and carpet with Vinyl Composition Tile.
- ✓ Hallways and door frames were also repainted.
